

Images, and steps may differ depending on the version of your android device. These pictures were taken on a Galaxy S8 with Android Version 8 (Oreo).

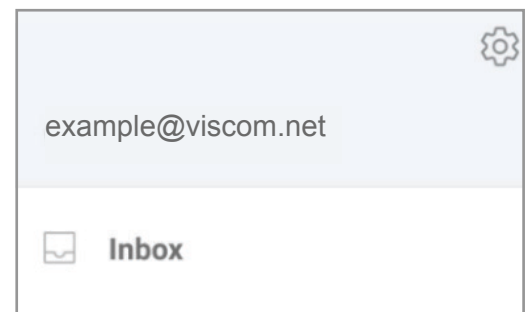
step 1 First click the [EMAIL BUTTON](#).
It may look different depending on version.



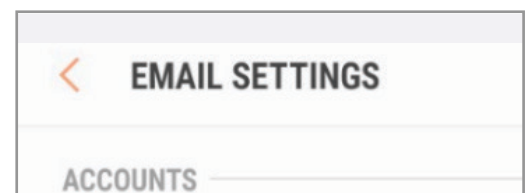
step 2 Then [CLICK](#) the three lines in the top left to see settings; OR in other versions, [CLICK](#) the three dots in the top right corner.



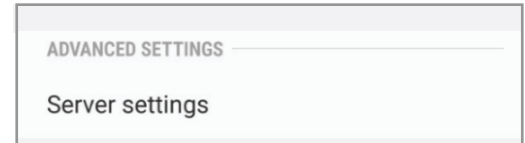
step 3 Then click the [SETTINGS WHEEL](#) at the top of the screen.



step 4 Once you're on the [EMAIL SETTINGS](#) page, click on your email address under [ACCOUNTS](#).



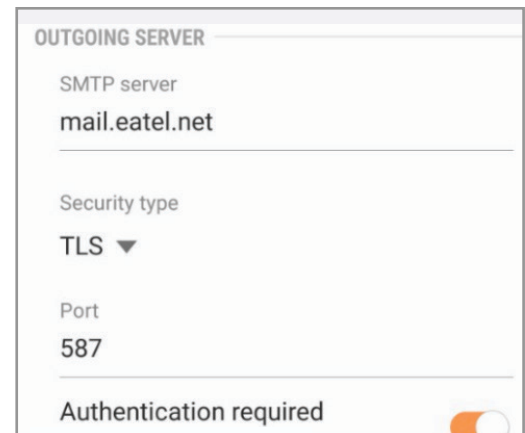
step 5 Once you're on the next page, scroll to the bottom and under ADVANCED SETTINGS select [SERVER SETTINGS](#).



step 6 Now you will need to make sure the server settings are as follows:
UNDER INCOMING SERVER
IMAP SERVER: [mail.eatel.net](#)
SECURITY TYPE: [SSL](#)
PORT NUMBER: [993](#)



UNDER OUTGOING SERVER
SMTP SERVER: [mail.eatel.net](#)
SECURITY TYPE: [TLS](#)
PORT NUMBER: [587](#)
AUTHENTICATION REQUIRED is turned [ON](#)
